A note for LEMS:

We have returned to the altar rail for communion, but the rector has directed that for now all parishioners will continue to receive the bread and wine by intinction – or, if they prefer, the bread only.

LEMS: When distributing communion, please wear the provided gloves. For each parishioner, dip the wafer into the wine and drop it into the communicant's hand; do not touch him or her, and do not touch your own mouth or face. If you do so inadvertently, please put on a fresh pair of gloves. If you have any questions, please ask the rector.

In the interests of keeping everyone safe, full vaccination, masks and gloves (provided) are required for all LEMS.

Notes for Lectors:

The first lector listed for the 10 a.m. service each Sunday reads the Old Testament (first) lesson. The second lector listed reads the New Testament (second) lesson. The third reads the Prayers of the People. Now that we have an organist (huzzah!), we have returned to chanting the psalm when the choir is present. The first reader will lead the psalm when the choir takes its summer break (beginning about the second week in June and continuing until early September)..

The rector has requested that you introduce your readings by saying “A reading from [the book of] _____.” You can omit “the book of” if you wish, and just say “A reading from Genesis,” or “a reading from First Kings,” or whatever is appropriate. Please do not cite chapter and verse. If it's an Epistle, please use this form: “A reading from Paul's first letter to the Corinthians” or “A reading from the first letter of Peter.” Conclude by saying, “The Word of the Lord.” The congregation will respond, “Thanks be to God.”
